

## WHAT IS TICKET TO WORK?

Ticket to Work is a Social Security Administration program for people ages 18-64 who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI), or both. The goal is to offer job services that will assist eligible SSI/SSDI beneficiaries to enter the workforce and gain more independence.

<b>Social Security Administration</b>	
<b>Ticket to Work and Self-Sufficiency</b>	<small>This ticket is issued to you by the Social Security Administration under the Ticket to Work and Self-Sufficiency Program. If you want help in returning to work or getting work for the first time, you may offer this ticket to an Employment Network of your choosing or take it to your State vocational/rehabilitation agency for services. If you choose an Employment Network and it agrees to take your ticket, or if you choose your State agency and you qualify for services, these providers can offer you services to help you go to work.</small>
Ticket Number 123-45-6789TW	<small>An Employment Network provides the services at no cost to you. The Social Security Administration will pay the Employment Network if you assign your ticket to it, and the Employment Network helps you go to work and complies with other requirements of the Program. An Employment Network serving under the Program has agreed to abide by the rules and regulations of the Program under the terms of its agreement with the Social Security Administration for providing services under the Program. Your State agency can tell you about its rules for getting services.</small>

## ADVANTAGES TO ASSIGNING YOUR TICKET

- » Expedited Reinstatement of Benefits - If you have to stop working, you can easily return to your benefits.
- » If your cash benefits end because of earnings and you lose your job because of your same disability (within 5 years), you do not have to reapply for Social Security Benefits.
- » Medical reviews are waived while participating in Ticket to Work.
- » You can keep your Medicare or Medicaid after cash benefits end due to work or earnings.
